



### **2013 /14 Super League Rules**

1. **SPARE RULE:** *Anyone can spare for a Super League team as long as they are NOT a current member of another Lethbridge Super League team. You can have as many spares as you want to field a team and these spares can play any position. This rule is in place to help avoid the need for cancelled games*
2. **MAKE UP GAME RULE:** All games must be played prior to or on the scheduled date. If a team cannot play on the scheduled date they must arrange to play it prior to the scheduled date or receive a loss for the game. The team being requested to play a make-up game prior to the scheduled game must make every effort to accommodate the scheduling of this make-up game.  

The Super League Committee will and can make the final decision of a win or lose if there is a dispute. *Exceptional, extenuating circumstances will be dealt with by the Super League committee on an individual basis. Please, look ahead in your schedule, identify weeks where there will be an issue and make the effort to get the game played prior to its scheduled week.*
3. **TIE RULE:** There *will* be ties in the *round robin* portion of Super League where the money will be split 50/50. There will be **NO TIES** in the playoff format. *An extra end or ends must be played to have a winner in the Playoff round(s).*
4. **PLAYOFF RULE:** The playoff format, to be determined in the coming weeks will be held in the week(s) following the regular season. To be determined at this time is the precise format, the amount of winnings available, and the dates. The committee will have this prepared in the coming weeks. NOTE: Playoff winnings **WILL** count toward your teams overall standings and ultimately the league champion.
5. **FUNDRAISING RULE:** As in previous years, fundraising by our Super League members helps to support the winnings available throughout the season and the playoffs. It also helps to justify the investment made in our league by the Club, showing the club that we are not just taking, but giving back as well. Each member of each team will be issued at least one book of Football (CFL) Pull Score Tickets this year. The tickets sell for \$5.00/ea and each member will have at least one book of 25 tickets to sell. The Lethbridge Curling Club and Super League Committee have been selling tickets prior to the start of Super League and the remaining books will be divided out between the Super League teams. We would encourage each member, when you get your package and your tickets on week one, to consider paying in advance for your book of tickets. This enables you to sell freely until the deadline date and then the only thing to hand in is your book of sold tickets. It makes the job of coordinating and collecting prior the event easier on the organizing committee.
